Designed by Donald Steel & Co. the course opened in 2001 and in this short period has been host to many national events, including the 2006 Scottish Amateur Strokeplay Championship and was a qualifying course for the 2007 British Seniors Open at Muirfield.

With challenging greens, cavernous bunkers and spectacular views over the Firth of Forth, Gullane Hill and out towards Edinburgh and Fife, Craigiellaw Golf Club is an experience not to be missed.



Longniddry Golf Course is a unique combination of woodland and links located on the south side of Firth of Forth. The Club is a former venue of the British Seniors and a qualifier for the Open at Muirfield. More recently the Club has hosted the Ladies Home Internationals and the Commonwealth Youths Tournament.

The Clubhouse is in a superb location, with, to the west, spectacular panoramic views of the Pentlands, Arthur's Seat and Edinburgh Castle. The outlook to the north is over the beach and the Firth of Forth to the Ochil Hills and Fife.



Luffness New Golf Club was established in 1894 when its course was designed by Old Tom Morris. A challenging traditional links course, recently lengthened and with a second par 5 hole introduced, is a host for qualifying rounds of the Open Championship. The course can be hard – mighty hard – when the wind blows down the Forth and the rough is thick enough to whet the whistle of a hungry herd.

Luffness offers a feeling of escape, allied to a sense of challenge and enjoyment that few other courses can match.



The fantastic James Braid designed East Course at Dalmahoy is a true championship venue. The course is now designed in such a way that it would be worthy of hosting any professional or amateur event from any world circuit.

Beautiful views towards the Forth Road and Rail Bridges can be seen from the higher points of the course. Although only a fifteen minute drive from the centre of the capital of Scotland, you will enjoy the peace and tranquility of the Lothians countryside.
